Sometimes, your availability does not match the shifts we need filled. We may offer you a position as an **‘on-call substitute’**. These are not guaranteed hours. Each week we send out an email to all student employees, listing shifts that need to be filled for the following week. You would have the opportunity to pick up shifts on a weekly basis – maximum of 28 work hours per week and limited by the demands of your classes. **Please do not indicate you are available as on-call if you do not intend to pick up at least one shift a week.**

Those blocks with ‘NO’ noted in them indicate that the shift listed at the left is not available that day.
